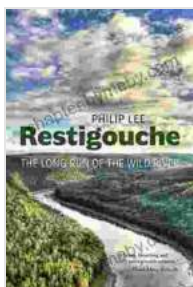


Restigouche: The Long Run of the Wild River

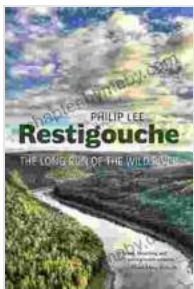

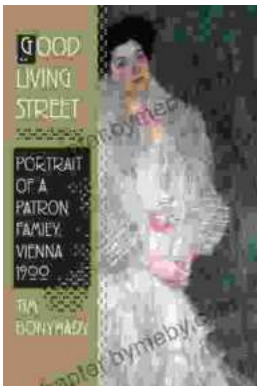
