

Eye Shapes and Expressions



Intense, but not evil
The pupil is small, which give a somewhat crazy or angry feeling, but the outline of the eye is rounded. The thick and straight eyebrows is more masculine.



Friendly, Innocent Girl
Larger eye, and long lashes. The pupil is full, to show openness. The shade is big, and the eyebrow, white, straight, is thin. A downward slant also makes the eye friendlier.



Mysterious Girl
A slightly smaller eye with an upward slant makes the eye more mature, and exotic feeling. A large pupil shows that the character is not mean-spirited.



Harsh or Cold Guy
The outline and eyebrow are drawn with sharper angle. There is a slight upward slant and the pupil is smaller and the shadow from the top of the eye is not drawn.



Aged
The eyebrow is more arched and perhaps uneven. Instead of drawing lashes, draw wrinkles. Make sure the eye is smaller unless you are going for a bug-like look.



Friendly, Innocent Boy
Larger eye, big pupil, shadow from the top of the eye and shine. The eyebrows are straighter and thicker. But not too thick. A downward slant makes the eye seem friendlier.



**Evil or
Very Angry**

Very sharp and dark lines. Small pupil and no shadow from the upper eye. Draw the eye very narrow and give it an upward slant.



Crazy Girl

To give a character a crazy look, draw the full circle of the iris. Make the pupil small and do not draw shadow from the upper eye. Add an upward slant, otherwise the character may just look surprised.
