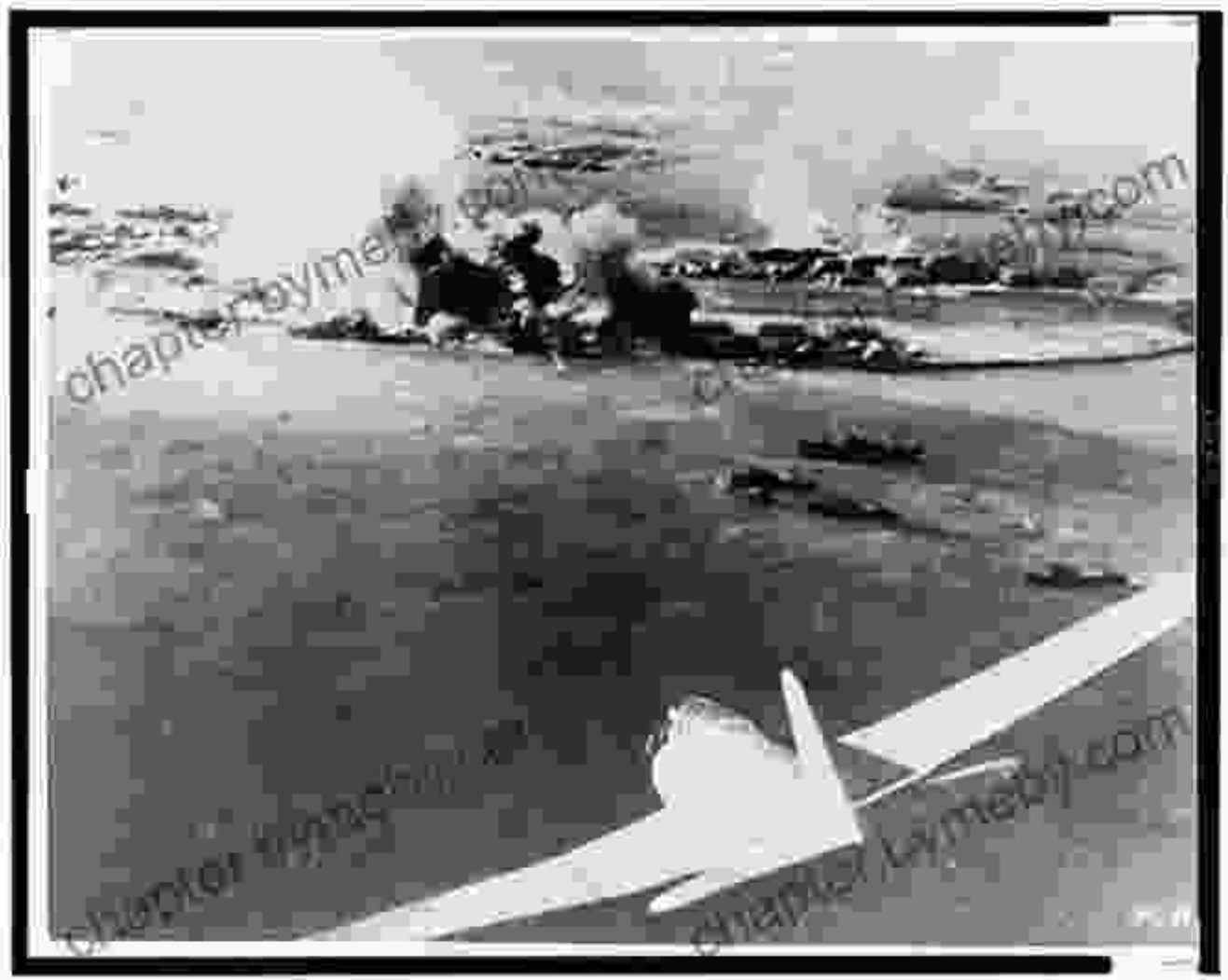


Image Caption: A Japanese aircraft drops a bomb on Pearl Harbor during the December 7, 1941 attack.

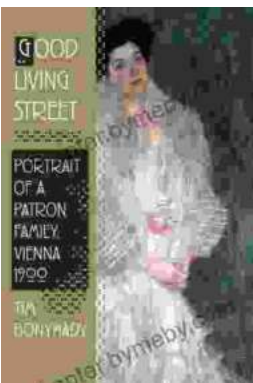
