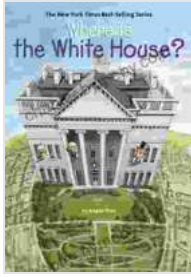

Visitors will also be able to see the White House gardens and the South Lawn.

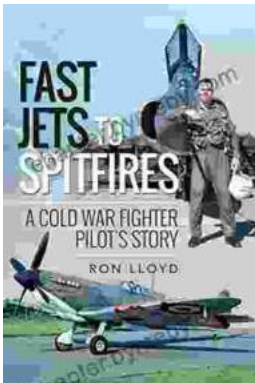

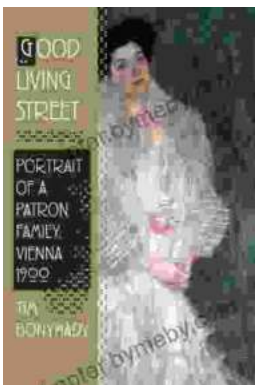
